

PAINTBALL REGISTRATION
BY READING THIS DOCUMENT YOU UNDERSTAND THAT:

- You must comply with the game rules.
- You will attend the safety briefing before commencing the activity.
- You will use all equipment as instructed.
- You will not use any equipment and/or other such item as a weapon so as to intentionally injure and/or hurt anyone.
- You agree to take care of all equipment loaned to you.
- You will be responsible to pay for any wilful damage caused to the equipment and/or loss thereof.
- The playing area has varying terrain and is slippery with pot holes and other types of trip hazards present.
- The playing area consists of obstacles that include ditches, fences, boulders, loose stones, compacted stones, mud, water, nettles, thistles and other undergrowth, trees, branches and/or game props such as vehicles, dummy rockets, ponds, ditches, wooden structures, brambles, other form of vegetation and/or undergrowth, bridges and communication towers.
- You accept that by taking part in the activities that you will encounter the types of obstacles and/or hazards (but not limited to those) as set out herein and by doing so you accept there is a real possibility that such an encounter could result in you suffering harm in the form of personal injury and/or other loss and/or damage.
- As part of the activities you accept that you will be the target for other players who are likely to fire ammunition and/or throw other items as issued by the activity provider at yourself.
- Although you will be issued with an over suit, face mask and safety instructions you accept that you are at a real risk of injuring yourself, by not limited to, any of the means as set out herein.
- You accept that by taking part in the activities there is a real risk you may injure yourself and/or that your actions could result in you injuring others who are involved in the activity.
- You accept that you are content to take the above risks even though these have been brought to your attention prior to the activity commencing.
- In the event that you injure yourself, another player and/or any other individual who may be within the vicinity of the activity then you agree to indemnify the activity provider as regards any loss and/or damage as subsequently claimed for and/or contended for by the said individual who may thereafter bring a claim for damages.
- Pyrotechnics may be used (by over 18's), and these may cause loud bangs, and create high temperatures which can burn. If you purchase any such item from the activity provider or otherwise come to be in possession of the same then you agree only to use such items on site and in the manner explained to you and furthermore, that you accept any responsibility for using the same, whether on site or not, and will in any event further indemnify the activity provider in respect of any loss caused as a result of such use.
- You will come into contact with pressurised air cylinders during the activity.
- Face masks will be issued and you accept these must not be removed under any circumstances during the duration of a game and you will only remove the mask when instructed by a safety marshal when it is safe to do so.
- You must pay all charges incurred before leaving the site and/or any administration fee that may be added.
- The company does not offer players personal injury insurance and you accept that if you wish to avail yourself of such a policy then you should do so prior to commencing the activity.
- You are not permitted to use your own paintballs
- Anyone found to break any of the rules of the game will be asked to leave at the sole discretion of the activity provider at which point all sums found to be owing will have to be satisfied in full.
- Vehicles are parked on site at the owners risk and no responsibility will be accepted for any valuables lost and/or stolen whilst on the site and/or any other such damage as may be suffered to such property and/or chattels howsoever caused.

The following persons are not to be allowed to participate in any games:

- a) Anyone who is or appears under the influence of alcohol or drug
- b) Anyone who is pregnant
- c) Anyone who has had an operation within the past twelve months that through participating in paintball the object of the operation could be aggravated
- d) Anyone undergoing medical treatment for an ailment that may be aggravated by paintball, including but not limited to high blood pressure, epilepsy, back problems, neck problems or any heart condition.
- e) Anyone suffering from any other condition that may be aggravated by paintball
- f) Please consult your doctor for advice
